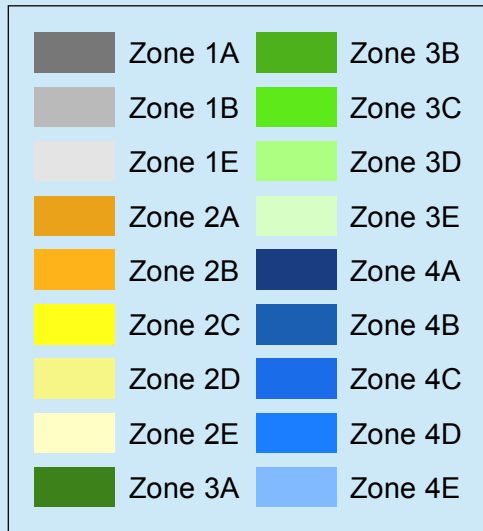


Seed Variety Selection Tool for the Hawaiian Islands
